

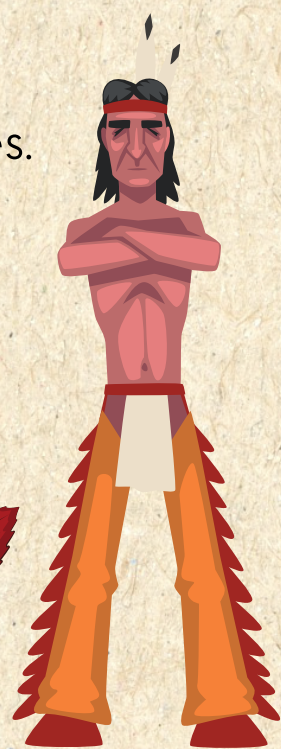
5 FACTS ABOUT

November



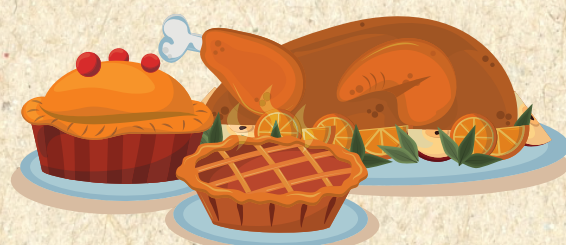
Abraham Lincoln proclaimed it a national holiday in 1863 and later Ulysses S. Grant signed the law which included Thanksgiving as a federal holiday.
